How to Prevent and Prevail Over the Flu

Part 3

We have been noticing some comparisons between the flu and sin. They are similar in their widespread scope, similar in the fact that both can lead to death, and similar in the way that they can be prevented and prevailed over. Four striking similarities that we want to notice: two ways to prevent and two ways to prevail over the flu and sin. We have noticed the two ways to try and prevent the flu - take precautions and avoid contact. Now we want to notice the first step that we can take to try and prevail over the flu and sin if we have contracted them.

Third, recognize the signs. If we are unfortunate and contract the flu, then we need to be able to recognize the signs. The signs of the flu include the following: fever (usually high), aches and pains, weakness, headache, dry cough, sore throat, and watery discharge from the nose. The first step to overcoming the flu, if you have it, is to recognize the symptoms.

It is also very important to recognize sin when it creeps into our life. James tells us how sin enters and the ultimate result if that sin is left unchecked. "But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is fullgrown, brings forth death" (James 1:14-15). In our country, we have become complacent with sin. Homosexuality is called an alternate lifestyle; the killing of an unborn child is called a choice; adultery is called an affair. God calls all of these things sin. We must learn to recognize the signs when sin creeps into our lives.

Next week we will notice the final way that we can prevail over the flu and sin.
