Does the Great Commission Apply to Me?

I was recently asked the question expressed in the title of this article. It wasn't asked to abscond from one's personal responsibility to teach others as sometimes is the case. It wasn't asked from the perspective of trying to confuse or complicate what Christians are to do or not do in reference to sin and the world around them. It was asked to know how to show others that we have been given a tremendous responsibility from our Lord.

To begin to answer this question, let's notice the passage. "And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:18-20, ESV).

It is true that in the context of the passage Jesus is speaking to the 11 apostles (Matt. 28:16). It is true that there are passages in Scripture that do not apply to us today So how do we know that this command given to the apostles applies to us as well? Let's notice a few reasons together.

First, it is important to understand that the apostles were given delegated authority. As stated in our text, Jesus has all authority, but Scripture indicates he delegated authority to the apostles. Once Jesus ascended, the apostles were His mouthpiece on the earth. As they Sun. Night Worship-6 PM commanded people by word and letter to teach others, it was the same as Jesus commanding them.

If only the apostles were to carry out the Great Commission, then once they and those they taught died, the church would cease to exist. Instead, Paul told Timothy to commit the things he had been taught to other faithful men who would then teach others (2 Tim. 2:2). Likewise, the letters written to various churches and individuals in the New Testament were not just for those churches and individuals. They were instructed to circulate those letters because they applied to all Christians including us today (Col. 4:16).

Next week we will notice two more reasons that show that the Great Commission applies to us today. ~Justin


