"Come Worship with Us!"

You might not think about it much, but you, as an individual, have a huge impact on the Ripley church of Christ. Those who are hypocrites; that treat Christianity as a hobby and not a way of life do much harm to the cause of Christ. We have to guard ourselves to make sure that we are setting the right examples and living as we should. You never know who is watching! Because of you, some may never become a Christian.

Because of you, some may become discouraged and unfaithful. The words that we speak and the attitude that we have can discourage our fellow Christians and may cause some to become unfaithful. Such was the case of the children of Israel when the twelve spies went out (Numbers 13). Ultimately, it is the responsibility of each individual to remain faithful, but if we become a stumbling block to our brethren, we may be held accountable. Because of you, some may become unfaithful.

Because of you, some may be encouraged and strive to live faithfully until death. Christians are supposed to be a source of strength and encouragement for one another. We are to build one another up, not tear each other down. We should always strive to help each other, and be there for one another. Because of you, some may be faithful to Christ.

I pray that each one of us can say with confidence, "Because of me, the Ripley church of Christ is influenced and impacted for good and is better than ever!"
