I Gave It

We sing a song entitled "I Gave My Life for Thee." Each verse illustrates some things that Christ has done for us and then asks what we have done in return. Four questions are posed: What hast thou given for Me? Hast thou left aught for Me? What hast thou borne for Me? What hast thou brought for Me?

We must be willing to give of ourselves in order to follow Christ. Our time, ability, and financial resources must be brought under His control.

We must be willing to leave some things in order to follow Jesus. Worldly pleasures must be forsaken. Worldly friendships may need to be severed. Some worldly ventures may need to be halted. These things and others may need to be left as we pursue faithfulness.

We must also be willing to undergo some things for Christ. Paul told Timothy that the Godly "will suffer persecution" (2 Timothy 3:12). We may have to bear some difficulties as a result of our allegiance to the Savior.

Finally, we must bring our lives to Him as a living sacrifice. "I Sun. Worship-10:30 AM | beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you Sun Night Worship-6 PM present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service" (Romans 12:1).


