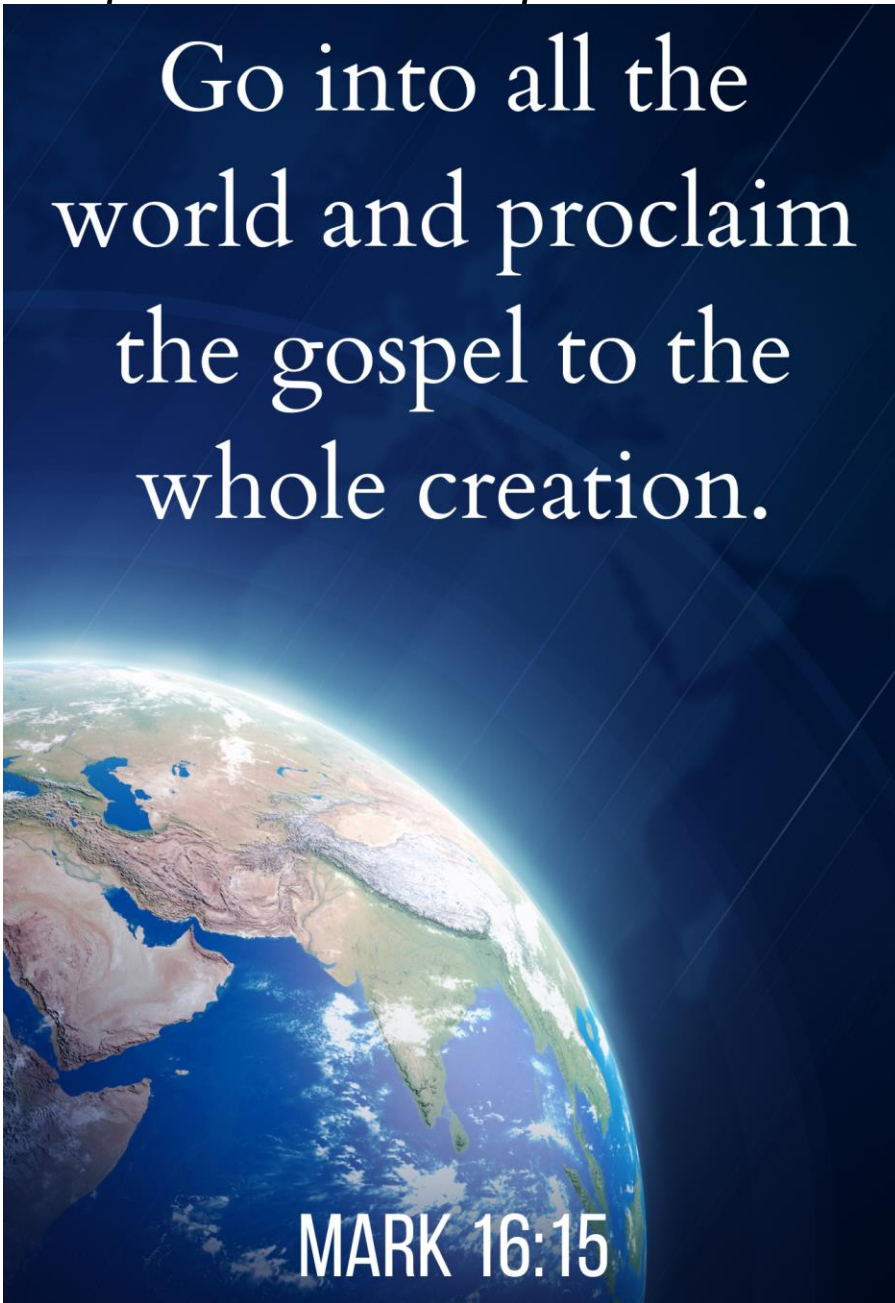

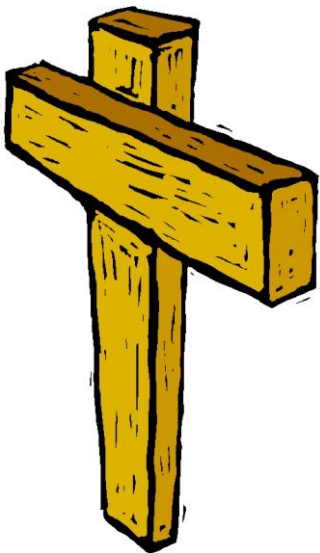


Mark Your Calendars!
